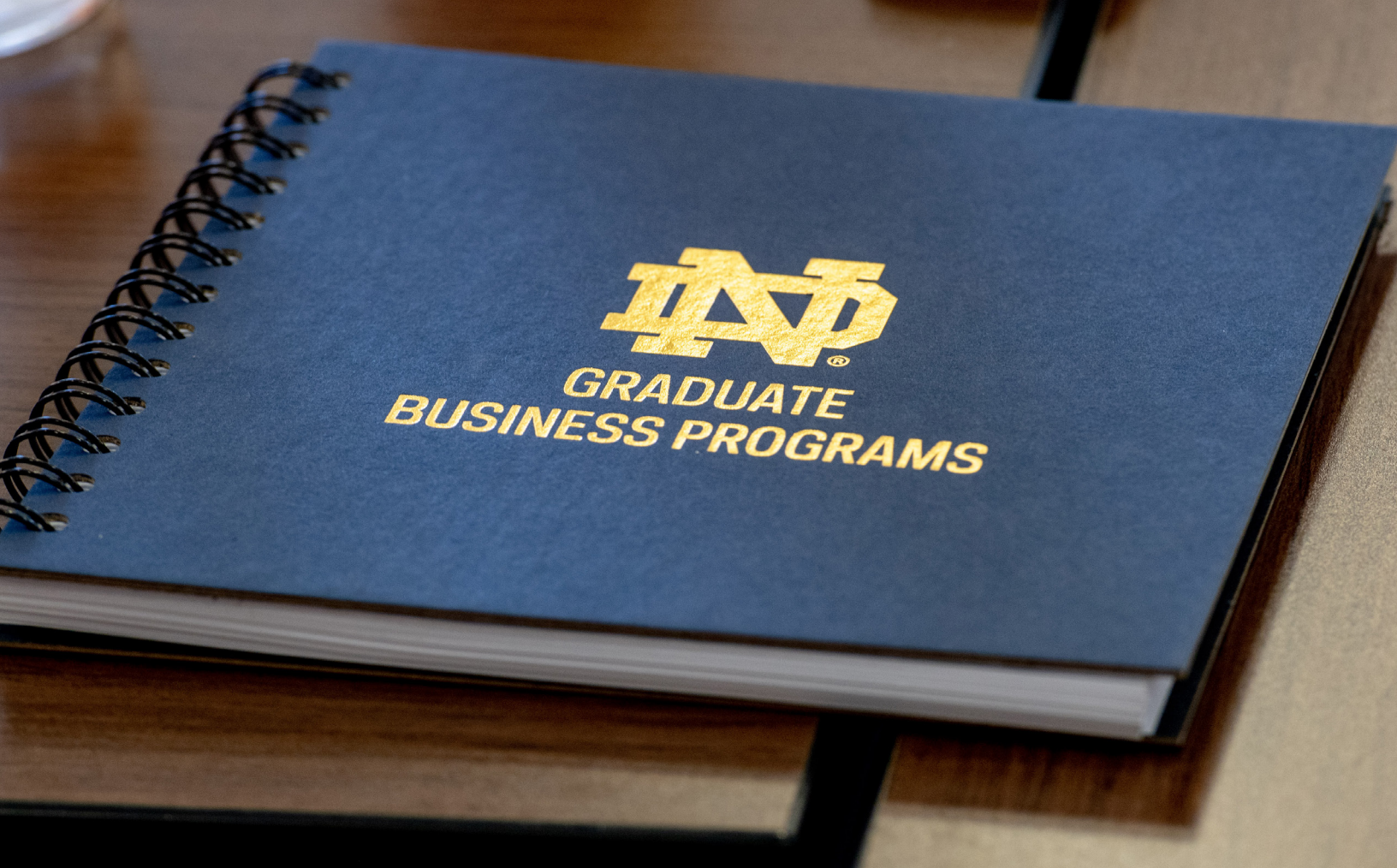




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THE NOTRE DAME MBA

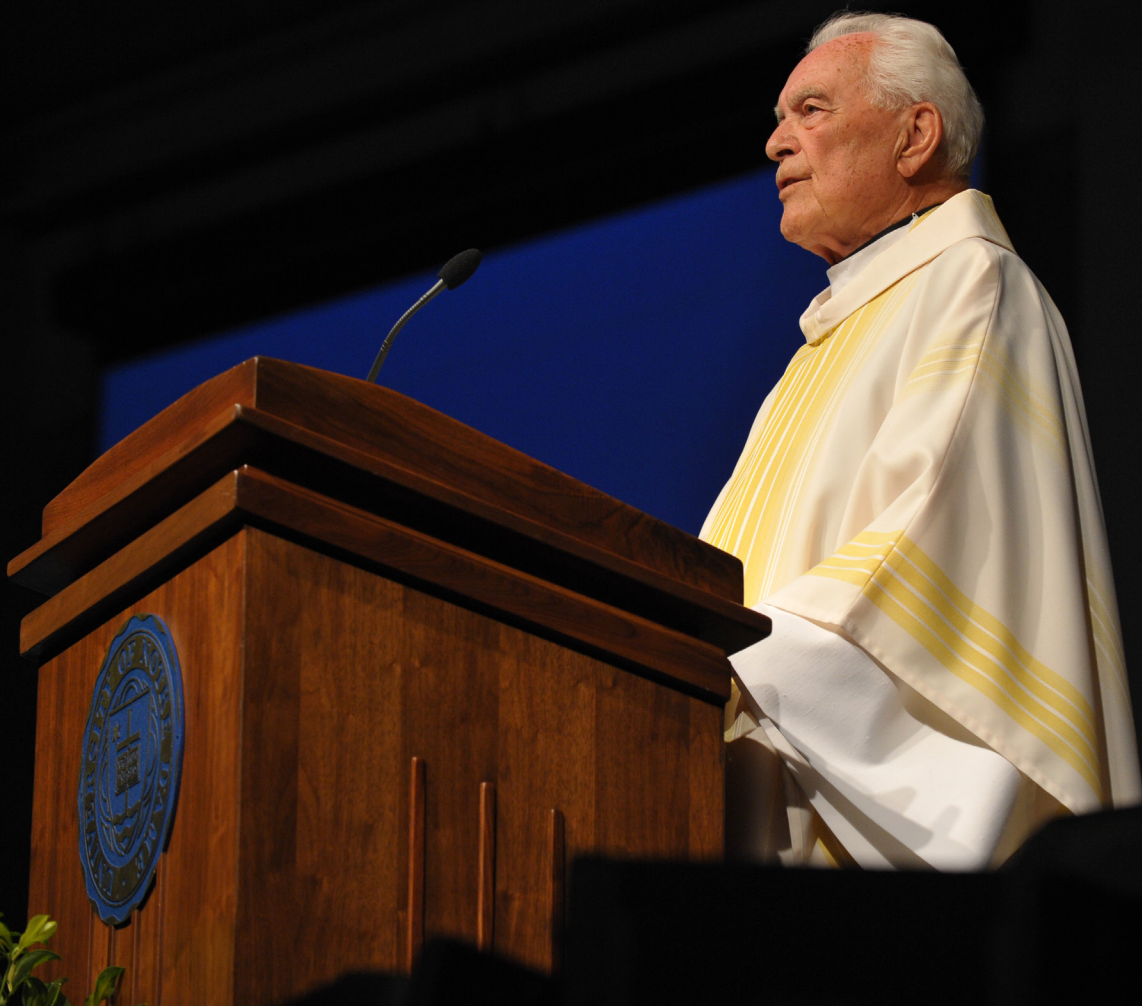
Despite its distinctive profile and unsurpassed training in servant leadership, forty years after its founding, the program struggled to attract top talent in an increasingly challenging global marketplace.
