"Our Need to Talk Ministry provides the opportunity for people at Notre Dame to seek out the listening ear and pastoral presence of our Campus Ministry Staff. Each Monday through Thursday, a Campus Minister from our staff is present for two hours in the evening. They are there to receive any member of our community who needs to talk through a situation, wants to grow deeper in faith, or has something weighing on their heart. In this space, we are able to bring the hospitality and compassion of Christ to each person that comes in and share in their joy, hope, and sorrow. This is a simple but profound ministry. We will usually see at least one person take advantage of this opportunity each night, though at times more. We have walked with students grieving the loss of a loved one or a relationship. We have also introduced people to ways of prayer and encountering God or connecting them with other resources in Campus Ministry or across campus. This space, both physically and figuratively, is sacred in that we truly have the opportunity to encounter Christ and to be Christ's hands and feet, ears and mouth to those we serve."
